

**Decision of UNI Europa affiliates representing employees of Manpower Group**

**MANPOWERGROUP – Request for a Special Negotiating Body**

3 June 2013, Brussels

According to the European Directive 2009/38/EC of 6 May 2009 and Article L2342-1 and subsequent articles of the French Labour Law, we request the establishment of a Special Negotiating Body, since the conditions for it have been met.

This request is brought forward, pursuant to Article L. 2342-4 of the Labour Law, by the unions CGT Manpower France and Filcams-CGIL (Italy), which represent workers in the Group. As you know, "Manpowergroup-France" is legally bound to establish the Special Negotiating Body within six months after a legitimate request is made by 100 employees or their representatives in two or more countries in the European Economic Area.

This initiative is unanimously supported by the representatives of the countries as signed below.

Furthermore, we would like UNI-Europa, a trade union structure representing affiliates in our professions at the European level, to be involved in the negotiations.
